

We want to inform you as soon as possible about some recent decisions taken by the Stated Clerk and the Office of the General Assembly related to the 225<sup>th</sup> General Assembly (2022):

All participants who attend the General Assembly at the Presbyterian Center in Louisville must be fully vaccinated for COVID-19. Proof of vaccination will be required during the registration process. This action was taken both to protect the health and safety of all who work at Presbyterian Center in Louisville, the location of the assembly, but also for the health and safety of everyone coming to participate in the General Assembly.

Commissioners and advisory delegates must participate in their assigned committee in-person in Louisville. The Office of the General Assembly does not have the capacity to provide for hybrid<sup>1</sup> participation in multiple simultaneous committee meetings.

The expectation is that each individual commissioner and advisory delegate will be present for both in-person committees and on-line plenary. Attendance in live on-line training is required before participating in the assembly.

All assembly participants, even those who will not be present in person in Louisville, are expected to register. This includes commissioners, advisory delegates, corresponding members, and other official participants. All others will have access to live-stream and be able to follow the business on PC-Biz.
